BASE BID DESCRIPTION:

Work of the Contract consists of removal and disposal/recycling of existing playground, site excavation, grading, and subgrade preparation. Work also includes, providing concrete playground curb/border, below-grade drain pipe system, base material, poured-in-place safety surface material, asphalt paving, indicated site amenities including playground equipment, replace and finish grade topsoil and provide site/turf grass restoration as noted in the following:

1. Removal or salvage of existing playground sand material on site to supplement/amend topsoil (with Owner's approval only); strip and stockpile topsoil; site excavation, contouring, and grading; subgrade preparation/compaction; furnish and install specified granular base course materials; furnish and install concrete curb/playground border; furnish and install below-grade playground drain pipe system; furnish and install specified playground interior area crushed limestone TB base course material under playground synthetic safety surface material areas; provide specified synthetic (poured-in-place rubber) playground synthetic safety surface material; furnish and install asphalt pavement; furnish and install playground equipment including site amenities, replace and finish grade salvaged/stockpiled topsoil; site/turf grass restoration (including required/specified seed and turf grass watering and the provision of the mandatory minimum of two (2) turf grass mowings before Owner's final acceptance of the Contract Work); and final construction site clean up. Perform Work of Contract under unit price contract with Owner in accordance with Conditions of Contract. Work of Contract is identified in the following sections and on Drawings. Milwaukee County will furnish the Agreement form for signatures and bonding.
