Contract 1: The project scope includes a four inch directional bore originating at the cargo building to the MKE Train Station and other ancillary parking shelter buildings with intermittent manhole installation. Additionally a 72 single strand fiber optic cable will be installed from the airport terminal to the train station through the new directional bore and existing duct package.

Construction to begin in SPRING 2017.

Work of Contract shall be Substantially Complete by August 1, 2017.

One Pre-bid meeting will take place on November 9, 2016 at 10:00 A.M., meet in the Hardie Conference Room, in the GMIA Upper Level, Concourse C, Department of Public Works Administration, 5300 South Howell Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Parking is available in the hourly parking structure.

Bids are due via the Milwaukee County online bidding system, no later than 2 P.M., November 16, 2016.

Pursuant to Chapter 30, Milwaukee County Ordinances wage rates on the project have been established by Milwaukee County. Completed LCPtracker Labor Compliance software documentation is required. Effective 7/1/2010, Contractors shall employ a minimum of 50% of the Contract labor force with employees that reside in Milwaukee County (see Bid Documents for RESIDENCY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS).
