### BID SHEET

- The enclosed revised bid form should be used for April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 bid submittal.

### SPECIFICATIONS

- Item M-1 Mobilization. The contractor is responsible for providing low profile lighted barricades in all areas of concrete removal. The low profile barricades must be lighted with flags. A five foot gap between barricades is permissible. These barricades are in addition to the ones shown on the phasing plan sheet.
- Item M-2 Mobilization-Lighted LED Temporary Lighted 'X's. The lighted "X"s will be paid for under mobilization. The contractor is responsible for procuring & delivery the two unit's to the locations shown on the plans. The contractor will be responsible for the initial start-up and must demonstrate to airport personnel the operation of the unit(s). The day to day maintenance will be the responsibility of GMIA. The airport will retain lighted "X" ownership after project close.
- Under "Notice of Reception of Bids"

On page 00 01 00-2 of 3. Remove Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Requirements paragraph language.
