Work consists of reglazing two (2), two story skywalks connecting the main parking garage to the terminal building at GMIA, reglazing of two (2) adjacent stair towers, mechanical system upgrades, roofing and other work to prevent leaking at the intersection the skywalk and the terminal building as indicated on the project bid documents.

Work of Contract shall be Substantially Complete by October 31, 2017.

Effective 7/1/2010, Contractors shall employ a minimum of 50% of the Contract labor force with employees that reside in Milwaukee County (see Bid Documents for RESIDENCY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS).
