The fencing consists of chain link fabric buried 2'-0" below ground, and chain link above ground 8'-0" and 3 strands of barbed wire on 2'-0" arms. A small portion of the fence will be 6'-0" above ground with barbed wire. The contract will also include one gate with an additional gate as an alternate.
