#### **QUESTION**

1. What type of disciplines should be included on the RFQ design team?
2. Will present IT cable routes need to be expanded or are they adequate to handle the additional cabling requirements.
3. Do we need to submit a design cost with the RFQ submittal?

#### **RESPONSE**

1. The airport's RFQ evaluation team will be looking for consultant's or subs having expertise in airport camera surveillance technology, electrical distribution, computer networking, data room storage, architectural detailing, HVAC representation for data room conditioning and duct bank expansion.
2. Cable tray expansion will probably be required throughout airport terminal. The extent of expansion will be determined when the consultant's field survey is performed.
3. The RFQ submittal shall contain qualifications of team members. Include in the submittal packet relevant previous project experience. No cost proposal should be submitted.
