**BASE BID DESCRIPTION:**

Work of the Contract consists of asbestos containing material abatement and Re-spray of Fireproofing per code in the HVAC room at the Marcus Center as indicated on project bid documents.

Contractor shall have the expertise, equipment and own State of Wisconsin certified employees to perform Asbestos Remediation Work. Bid will be rejected if Contractor is incapable of performing work as stated above. Use no subcontracting except to achieve Owner's DBE goals. See DBE section for Contact goals. When requested by Owner, submit lists of personnel with training or trade, equipment owned, experience, previous similar Contracts including names and phone numbers and/or projects and persons to contact. Failure to submit information and/or documentation within 3 days after being requested, or the submission of incorrect information and/or documentation will be considered non-responsive and result in recommendation of rejection of bid, and if after award of Contract, termination of Contract. Contractor shall assume full responsibility and liability for compliance with the appropriate Federal, State and local regulations pertaining to work practices, hauling, disposal and worker protection. Contractor shall hold the Owner harmless for failure to comply with any applicable work practices, hauling, disposal or worker protection measures or other regulation on the part of Owners employees, or subcontractors. Contractor shall also abide by all the following requirements as appropriate for asbestos and regulated materials abatement, hauling or disposal: Federal, OSHA, DOT, EPA. State of Wisconsin WDNR WDHS Local Requirement Milwaukee Code of Ordinances 66-10, 66-12, & 66-19. Standards-Which apply to abatement work American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Perform Work of Contract under stipulated sum contract with Owner in accordance with Conditions of Contract. Work of Contract is identified in the following sections and on Drawings. Milwaukee County will furnish the Agreement form for signatures and bonding.
