Sealed bids are due in the County Clerk's Office, Room 105, Milwaukee County Courthouse, on February 13, 2013 at 2 P.M. Bids will be publicly read in Room 105, Milwaukee County Courthouse, 5 minutes after due time.

Pursuant to Chapter 30, Milwaukee County Ordinances wage rates on the project have been established by Milwaukee County.

Effective 1/1/2010, ALL PROJECT CONTRACTORS and SUB-CONTRACTORS shall file certified Payroll records with State of Wisconsin DWD on a monthly basis in a format that meets DWD reporting requirements (see Bid Documents for additional requirements). Federal Wage rates are also included in the project requirements.

This project has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal that is discretionary. (DBE goal process requirements and mandatory submittals for Milwaukee County follow 49 CFR part 26, 25 percent goal has been set by Milwaukee County).

This project requires that an affidavit of non-collusion be incorporated as a part of the proposal requirements provided to each prospective bidder. Failure to complete the sworn statement will make the bid non-responsive and not eligible for award considerations.

Bidder's attention is called to the "Notice of Requirements for Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity" (Executive Order 11246), contained in the Bid Documents, which set forth, in part, goals and timetables for the employment of women and minorities in the project area.

Chapter 43 of Milwaukee County Ordinances requires bidders to file 2 Contractor Qualification Statements with County Clerk, Room 105, Courthouse, 901 North 9th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53233. Qualification Statement forms to be used are available at Department of Administrative Services, Architecture, Engineering and Environmental Services Division, Milwaukee County City Campus, 2711 West Wells Street, 2nd Floor, Milwaukee, WI 53208. A copy of Chapter 43 is also available for review. Unless previously qualified under Chapter 43 of County Ordinance, submit Contractor Qualification Statement to County not less than 5 days before time set for receipt of bids to be qualified for this project. Sign Qualification Affidavit contained in Bid Documents. If Qualification Affidavit is not submitted with bid, bid will be rejected.

Bidders shall submit the completed Subcontractor-Supplier Information Sheet with the Bid. Failure to submit this information with Bid may result in rejection of the Bid as non-responsive.

A 10 percent bid bond or certified check is required with bid.

The low responsive, responsible bidder will be recommended for contract award. Owner reserves right to reject bid, to waive informalities in bid or to accept bid which will be in best interest of Owner.

Bids shall remain open to acceptance for a period of 60 days after bid due date.
