ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Project Name: GMIA Airfield Pavement
Re-habilitation - 2011.

Project Location: General Mitchell International Airport

Contract Description: The work under this contract will consist of the removal of existing concrete pavement joint sealant, re-sawing and sandblasting the joints, and installation of new joint sealant material for approximately 51,000 linear feet of pavement joints at General Mitchell International Airport. Partial depth concrete spall repairs of the existing pavement will also be performed. Partial depth repairs will involve milling the top 2 inches of pavement surface, cleaning, and patching of the pavement with an elastomeric concrete patch material. Crack routing and sealing of approximately 700 feet will also be performed. This work will be performed on the pavement of the inner Taxiway B between Taxiway A1 & Taxiway V. Full-depth removal and replacement of ten 16-inch deep concrete panels 20'x25' in dimension on Runway 1R-19L within the Runway 7R-25L safety area will also be performed.
