RE: JUVENILES CHARGED WITH ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OFFENSES AND JUVENILES 17 AND UNDER WAIVED TO ADULT COURT

Pursuant to Chief Judge Directive 96-18, issued by Judge Patrick T. Sheedy, and in accordance with SCR 70.19(3)(a) & (f):

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective July 1, 1996, juveniles charged with original jurisdiction offenses will be detained at the Juvenile Detention Center unless otherwise ordered by the court in which the juvenile's case is assigned; and,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, all original jurisdiction cases shall have the initial appearance, preliminary hearing and subsequent trial (if reversed) conducted by a circuit court judge assigned to the Children's Division; and,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, all original jurisdiction cases that are not reversed waived (upon completion of initial appearance, preliminary hearing and arraignment) be assigned for trial to the Felony Division; and,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, all original jurisdiction cases involving juveniles 15 or 16 who are not "Reversed Waived" shall be transported to the Criminal Justice Facility for booking and then shall be returned to the Juvenile Detention Center; and,


Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 938.18(8):

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, when a waiver is granted for a youth 16 and under, the juvenile shall be held in the Juvenile Detention Center pending all subsequent court hearings, including District Attorney Charging Conferences; and,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, if held in secured custody, the juvenile shall be transported by the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office from the Juvenile Detention Center to the adult court for all pending appearances and shall be eligible for bail in accordance with Chapters 968 and 969; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if a juvenile who has been waived and is detained at the Juvenile Court Detention Center becomes a discipline problem or a risk to others in the Detention Center, that juvenile may be transferred to an adult facility by order of the court.
