


RE: WORK DETAIL SENTENCE CREDIT

IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED that, effective July 13, 2014:

All inmates working within the Milwaukee County Jail or the Milwaukee County House of Correction in areas such as the kitchen, bakery, laundry room, print shop, and maintenance crews shall be eligible for additional sentence credit at the discretion of the Sheriff or the Superintendent of the House of Correction under the following conditions:

1. The credit shall not exceed one day for every 24 hours worked.
2. This credit is in addition to good time credit under §302.43 Stats.
3. The inmate must not be in violation of any rules at the jail or HOC.
4. The inmate must be accepted into the work detail under the rules at the jail or HOC.
5. Inmates convicted of a class A, B, or C felony as well as anyone convicted of any of the charges in the attached list are ineligible for additional credit.
