

RE: ASSIGNMENT OF CASES TO THE GUN COURT

IT IS HEREBY DIRECTED that, effective **October 31, 2015**, all new unlawful possession of firearm cases shall be assigned to a General Felony calendar using the General Felony intake schedule.

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that, effective **October 31, 2015**, unlawful possession of firearm cases include cases charged under the following statutes or any subsection of the following statutes:

- 941.26 Machine Guns/Other Weapons
- 941.27 Machine Guns
- 941.28 Possession of Short-Barreled Shotgun/Rifle
- 941.29 Possession of a Firearm
- 941.291 Possession of Body Armor
- 941.295 Possession of Electric Weapon
- 941.31 Possession of Explosives
- 948.605 Possession of Firearm in School Zone

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that, **effective October 31, 2015**, cases involving individuals charged as either defendant or co-defendant in Attempt Homicide, Recklessly Endangering Safety, Reckless Injury or other felony matters involving the discharge of a firearm shall be assigned to the Gun Court.

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that, all unlawful possession of firearm cases as defined in paragraph two of this directive that are currently assigned to the Gun Court that are not disposed of by **November 2, 2015** shall be disbursed among the General Felony Court calendars.

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED that, all unlawful possession of firearm cases as defined in paragraph two of this directive having a next scheduled hearing date of **November 2, 2015** or later shall be immediately transferred to a General Felony calendar.
