**INFORMATION FOR 2014 ELECTIONS**

<b>April 15, 2014</b>	First day to circulate nomination papers.
<b>June 2, 2014</b>	Last day (5:00 p.m.) for candidates to file nomination papers, declaration of candidacy, and campaign registration statement.
<b>August 12, 2014</b>	<b>PARTISAN PRIMARY</b>
<b>November 4, 2014</b>	<b>GENERAL ELECTION</b>

**REGISTRATION**

---

All candidates are required to file a Campaign Registration Statement, Form GAB-1, as soon as intent to seek elective office is known and before funds are collected or spent. The registration statement should be filed **before** circulating nomination papers. If a current registration statement is not filed by **Monday, June 2, 2014** the candidate's name may not be placed on the ballot.

**RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS**

---

Per Wisconsin Statute Section 59.20 (1) eligibility for county office, "No person may file nomination papers as a candidate for, have his or her name placed on a ballot for election to, or hold a county elective office who is not an elector of the county."

**NOMINATION PAPERS**

---

If a person signs nomination papers for two candidates for the same office in the election at different times, the earlier signature is valid. Candidates must file a Declaration of Candidacy with their nomination papers. All Declaration of Candidacy papers must be notarized.

**NOTIFICATION OF NON-CANDIDACY**

---

Any incumbent officeholder who does not intend to seek re-election should file a Notification of Non-Candidacy (GAB-163) no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 23, 2014. If an incumbent not seeking re-election does not file the notification by the required statutory deadline to seek re-election, the filing deadline will be extended an additional 72 hours for any other person wishing to run for that office. The deadline is not extended for the incumbent. If an incumbent not seeking re-election files the notification timely, the nomination paper deadline of June 2, 2014 is unchanged. If the incumbent has a change of heart after filing the notification, he or she can run for re-election by filing the appropriate ballot access papers by the normal deadline.

## STATEMENT OF ECONOMIC INTERESTS

---

Candidates shall file a Statement of Economic Interests with their nomination papers per Chapter 9, County General Ordinances. Forms will be sent to candidates or their treasurers approximately two weeks before filing deadline.
