### **PRATT CONGRATULATES GULOTTA-CONNELLY ON RETIREMENT**

*County Executive Congratulates her for 31 Years of Public Service*

**Milwaukee, WI** – Interim County Executive Marvin Pratt today congratulated Milwaukee County Transit System Managing Director Anita Gulotta-Connelly on her announcement that she is retiring after 31 years with MCTS. Gulotta-Connelly announced recently that her retirement is effective April 1.

“Anita is a public servant in the truest sense of the term,” Pratt said. “For more than 31 years she has worked to ensure that Milwaukee County’s transit system operates at a high level. Even in times when MCTS was affected adversely by funding cuts and other issues, Anita and her staff found creative ways to continue to serve the county’s bus riders. She was a strong advocate for dedicated funding for public transit.”

Pratt said that under Gulotta-Connelly’s leadership, MCTS distinguished itself by maintaining essential services even under difficult circumstances. He added that among her many accomplishments, Gulotta-Connelly helped create a transit system that provided more rides-per-capita for less cost-per-ride of any of 13 “peer” systems.

“I want to congratulate Anita and thank her for all she has done for Milwaukee County and those who use the transit system,” Pratt said. “She will truly be missed, and I wish her all the best in retirement.”
