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Considerations for a Continuum of Care

Mother/Child/Family as a Unit

- ▶ Judicial and Child Welfare
 - ▶ Confidentiality and Working with Statutes
- ▶ Prevention and Early Intervention
 - ▶ All Systems
- ▶ Treatment and Physical Health Care Services
 - ▶ Consideration for Harm Reduction
- ▶ Recovery and Wellness



Vermont's CHARM Model

CHARM: Children and Recovering Mothers

- Multidisciplinary group (obstetrics, neonatology, substance abuse counselor, social worker, Child Welfare, visiting nurses, MAT)
- Meet monthly
- Maintain a case list
- Follow-up for a year post-partum
- All patients sign a consent for discussion
- There is a Memorandum of Understanding among all groups regarding the use of information

Goal: *To ensure wrap around services are available to all patients; Child Welfare is then aware of who is engaged in treatment and who is not*
