a graphical summary of various pieces of important information


This public dashboard presents data relating to the mental health system in Milwaukee County.


The dashboard will be updated quarterly, as new data become available, or as additional progress measures are identified.

**PCS:** Psychiatric Crisis Service (Behavioral Health Division emergency department)


# PCS Admissions by Legal Status, 2008-13





# BHD Adult Inpatient Admissions, 2008-13




# BHD Access Clinic Utilization, 2010-13





# Certified Peer Specialists in Milwaukee County, 2011-13




