We are looking for volunteers to visit assigned wetlands multiple times throughout March-June of 2016 to gather essential data on the unique and sensitive wildlife populations present within them! Volunteers will be trained and provided with wetland monitoring kits to conduct aquatic funnel trapping surveys to look for amphibians (salamanders, frogs, toads) and aquatic invertebrates (crayfish and fairy shrimp), as well as secretive marsh bird surveys!

The data that YOU collect is very important because the Parks Department will use it to guide the current and future habitat management activities within the Park System. An orientation will take place to showcase the project and let people know how they can get involved in this exciting new project!
