

Park Improvement Concepts

On June 24th, the design team presented three concepts to the stakeholder representatives at the South Shore Pavilion. The concepts were based on input received throughout the design process, and concentrated on four design elements:

- Trail Alignment
- Park Improvements
- Beach Design/Features
- Parking Lot and Vehicular Circ.

The stakeholders were able to choose design elements of each of the concepts that best meet their needs and expectations.

The design team will take all of the feedback and comments from the stakeholders and refine a consolidated concept with Milwaukee County staff for presentation at a public meeting in August.
