### **Music Under Glass Season - First Thursday in November Johnny Cash Tribute Opening Night (\$5 admission if you dress in all black)**

Milwaukee—(October 9, 2012) -Live music, computer light shows and a chance to escape the cold this winter are offered at Milwaukee’s highly anticipated “Music Under Glass,” a live concert series at the Mitchell Park Domes. The series will open with the Liam Ford Band’s tribute to Johnny Cash on Thursday, November 1 from 6:30 to 9 p.m. at The Domes, 524 S. Layton Boulevard. As part of the tribute, all attendees dressed in all black will be admitted at a discounted rate of \$5.

Every Thursday evening from November 1 through March 14, the region’s most celebrated, diverse and award-winning bands will perform in the Show Dome from 6:30 to 9 p.m. Light shows set to music will “wow the senses” during the band’s breaks and after each performance. Celebrations with prize giveaways from partners of the Milwaukee County Parks are scheduled throughout the series. (See schedule below.) Patrons are welcome to explore the Tropical and Desert domes, as well as the lobby, where parks partners will have information tables.

*“Music Under Glass helps Milwaukee celebrate the arts and musical talents of our local bands,” said Milwaukee County Executive, Chris Abele. “It is an exciting, weekly event that attracts residents during the fall and winter months to the Domes and serves as a haven to escape the winter weather while listening to great music, enjoying awe inspiring lightshows and tasting delicious food and drinks.”*

Two of the most popular shows will be in the Show Dome during the run of the music series. Beginning November 17, the holiday floral show, “Let it Snow,” will transform the Show Dome into a winter wonderland. Beginning January 19, the garden train show, “The Circus Comes to Town,” will open featuring G-scale trains running on over 500 feet of track, surrounded by a landscape created with miniature plants.

“Music Under Glass” at the Domes is fully funded through generous partnerships with the Milwaukee County Parks Department and The Park People. The presenting sponsor is Potawatomi Bingo/Casino. Other funding partners include WaterStone Bank, Blue Moon Brewing Company, VMP, Jo Jo’s Martini Lounge, and American Mortgage & Equity Consultants INC..

Admission to “Music Under Glass” is \$6.50 for adults and \$5 for youth ages 6-17. Food and beverages are available for purchase from Zilli Hospitality Group.
