### **THE DOMES TO HOST "DOUBLE-HEADER" LILY TALKS**

(Milwaukee, WI) March 31, The Wisconsin Illinois Lily Society will present a "double-header" talk hosted by Milwaukee County Parks "The Mitchell Park Domes" on Saturday, March 31, at 12.30 PM, as part of the Lily Society's public outreach program. The mission of the Wisconsin Illinois Lily Society, an affiliate of the North American Lily Society, is to further the knowledge and propagation of true lilies.

Woodruff Imberman will start the talk with a slide show/lecture "Making Your Milwaukee Garden Great with Lilies," immediately followed by Jerry Nelson, who will speak on "What Goes Great With Lilies." Those attending will learn which lilies grow best in the Milwaukee area, be taught simple propagation techniques for growing them, see pictures of the wide variety of lilies that flourish in our area, be schooled in the key elements of garden design, and find out which plants and shrubs best highlight the lilies in their gardens.

Imberman is president of the Wisconsin Illinois Lily Society, lectures widely on lilies at garden clubs throughout the Midwest. He is the author of numerous articles on lilies in regional and national horticultural magazines, is an amateur lily hybridizer, and has won many awards for his lilies in regional and national shows. Jerry Nelson is from Franksville, WI, and is president of Classic Gardens, Milwaukee's leading design firm, and host of WRJN radio's Saturday morning garden talk show.
