Take A Kid Ice-Fishing

Free Clinics offered at local Milwaukee County Parks

Milwaukee (January 18, 2012) – The 21st Annual Free Ice-Fishing Clinics for children ages 15 and under will take place, weather permitting, on Saturday, February 4, 2012 from 9am to 3pm at five Milwaukee County Parks. The clinics begin every hour with the last clinic starting at 2 pm. No pre-registration is required.

All fishing equipment will be furnished. Please dress warmly. Young children must be accompanied by an adult. Members of local fishing clubs will teach knot tying, safe use of equipment and proper techniques on the ice.
