Milwaukee County Parks Celebrate New Sherman Park Playground Ribbon cutting for new “Footsteps of Unity” playground

Milwaukee, WI (July 12, 2012) Milwaukee County Parks announce ribbon cutting at the new Sherman Park playground 3000 N Sherman Blvd on Friday, July 13th at 3:00pm.. The new Class-2 Playground is approximately 7,800sqft and has poured-in-place rubber surfacing. Playing off the Boys & Girls Club's "Footsteps of Unity" theme there are giant footprints meandering through the site. It is designed to focus on active play by having less decks and incorporating more climbing. The swings and play structures have been combined into one area to make supervision easier.

“The new playground gives our young people in the Sherman Park neighborhood a safe place to play and enjoy the summer,” said Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., who represents the Sherman Park neighborhood. “I thank my colleagues on the County Board and our great staff in the Parks Department for making this new playground a reality.”
