McKinley Marina Reconstruction Plan Presentation

Milwaukee, WI (May 31, 2013) “Planning for the Future of McKinley Marina,” an open house and public meeting, will take place, Thursday, June 6, 5-7 p.m., at the McKinley Marina Overlook, 1600 N. Lincoln Memorial Drive.

The meeting will focus on the recommended reconstruction of the marina’s 11 acres of paved surfaces to address water pollution challenges of an active marina. Comprising the area are boat launches, boat washes, dry dock storage, boat maintenance areas, vehicle parking, and pedestrian areas. McKinley Marina North-Phase 1: Site Investigation and Conceptual Design uses best management practices to address water runoff quality.

Illustrations will be available for review, and at 5:45 p.m., the formal presentation will describe the issues found at the site, the various solutions considered, and the final recommended plan.

Public parking for the meeting is available in the marina lot northeast of the Lincoln Memorial Drive and Lafayette Hill Road intersection, immediately left of the entrance.

The marina provides Lake Michigan access to thousands of Southeastern Wisconsin residents annually and is adjacent to Milwaukee’s other lakefront destinations, including McKinley and Bradford beaches.

McKinley Marina was the recipient of Wisconsin Clean Marina certification in 2011.
