Dedication of Currie Dog Exercise Area Expansion

Wauwatosa, WI (July 8, 2013) – County Executive Chris Abele and the Milwaukee County Parks Department will dedicate the 10-acre expansion of the Currie Park Dog Exercise Area (DEA), Friday, July 12 at 4 p.m. The off-leash DEA is located at 3535 N. Mayfair Road. The expansion is east of the parking lot at Capitol Drive and North 110 Street.

“The Currie off-leash dog area has been very popular and heavily used. This expansion will help us to meet the need for a safe, off-leash space for dog owners and their pets,” said Abele.

Additional DEAs are located at Granville, Estabrook, Runway, and Warnimont parks.

Daily or annual DEA permits are required for admission. The annual permit can be used at any of the Milwaukee County DEAs. The fee for a resident permit with one dog is \$25. Discounted fees are available for seniors and persons with disabilities. Non-resident fees are slightly higher.

Permits can be purchased at the DEAs; Parks Administration, 9480 Watertown Plank Road; Boerner Botanical Gardens, 9400 Boerner Drive; and in the community. For a complete listing, visit countyparks.com, and search “DEA permit locations.”
