Season Pass Prices Slashed at Family Aquatic Centers

Wauwatosa, WI (July 29, 2013) – Milwaukee County Parks announced today, that beginning Aug. 1, the cost of season passes to the family aquatic parks will be cut by 60%. Passes can be used through Labor Day at both Cool Waters in Greenfield Park, 2028 S. 124th St., and the David F. Schulz Aquatic Center in Lincoln Park, 1301 W. Hampton Ave. Passes may be purchased at either location during regular pool hours.

Cool Waters is open Mon.-Thurs. 10 a.m.-8 p.m., and Fri.-Sun. 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Cool Waters is a zero-depth, or beach-entry, heated pool. It features giant tube- and body-waterslides, a children's waterslide, interactive water toys, and three lap lanes. Food and beverages are available. Picnic shelters in the park can be rented for birthday parties, family gatherings, and corporate events.

David F. Schulz Aquatic Center open-swim hours are Mon-Thurs. noon-8 p.m. and Fri.-Sun. noon-6 p.m. Tot Time is open exclusively to children age 7 and under and their adult caregivers Mon.-Fri. 10 a.m.-noon. The Lazy River is the primary attraction. Tube- and body-waterslides, a diving area, and interactive water toys are also offered. Water toys include spray jets, spray posts, water troughs, The Bucket Dump, and more. Food and beverage concessions are available.

Individual passes will be available for \$20, family passes (up to 4 members) will be \$50, and passes for each additional family member will be \$10.
