Doggie Dip at Cool Waters, Labor Day

Milwaukee, WI (August 13, 2013) – On Labor Day, Cool Waters closes for the “human swimming season,” but before it is drained for the year, it will reopen at 6:30 p.m. for the 9th Annual Doggie Dip. Cool Waters is located at 2028 S. 124 St. in West Allis. The event is cosponsored by Residents for Off-Leash Milwaukee Parks and the Milwaukee County Parks.

Whether fearless about diving for tennis balls or wearing a personal floatation device, dogs of all abilities, breeds, and sizes are welcome to come for a swim in the pool.

Due to the popularity of the Doggie Dips, advance-admission wrist bands will be on sale the day before the event, Sun., Sept. 1, 10 a.m.-6 p.m. The wristband will allow the patron and dog to enter the pool without waiting in the admissions line. Admission is \$5 per dog.

A special on the 2013 Dog Exercise Area permits will be available. For one dog, regardless of the patron’s residency, the special price is \$10. A license number and rabies tag number are required for each of the dogs to be permitted.

The event runs 6:30 - 8 p.m., Monday, Sept. 2.

For area residents, Labor Day may mark the end of the summer swimming season, but for dogs, things are just getting started.
