“Footgolf” Comes to Milwaukee

Cross Between Soccer and Golf to be Played at Lincoln Park

Milwaukee—(October 9, 2013) – Footee Milwaukee is bringing the emerging sport of footgolf to Lincoln Park Golf Course, Friday, Oct. 11. Lincoln Park is located at 1000 W. Hampton Ave.

Footgolf, the cross between soccer and golf, uses a regulation soccer ball and 21-inch-diameter holes. The objective of the game is to advance the ball from the tee box into the hole in the fewest number of kicks.

For the event, Lincoln Park Golf Course has been transformed from a 9-hole regulation golf course into an 18-hole footgolf course.

“This should be a fun event for the folks who are into soccer or those who find regular golf a bit too challenging. And, because none of the footgolf holes were placed on the greens, the event won’t affect the quality of the course for our regular golfers,” said Jon Canavan, Turf Manager for Milwaukee County Parks.

Registration for the 1 p.m. shotgun start is still being accepted. Foursomes or individuals may register. Each participant receives a free Adidas soccer ball, two complementary beverages, and the chance to win prizes. Registration is \$100 per individual.
