**“Homemade Holiday” Open House at Wehr Nature Center**  
*Gift-Making, Cookie Exchange, Holiday Market*

Franklin, WI (November 26, 2013) Wehr Nature Center invites the public to its annual open house, “Homemade Holiday,” Saturday, Dec. 7, 11 a.m.-3:30 p.m., at 9701 W. College Ave. in Franklin.

Families and scout groups can stop in any time during the event hours to create homemade gifts from natural, recycled, and repurposed objects; to purchase homemade cookies for entertaining or gift-giving; and to buy holiday decorations.

Making three different projects is included in the admission fee for crafters. Projects include tree-cookie coasters, pencil holders, recycled crayons, a variety of holiday ornaments, and homemade wrapping paper. Non-crafters are admitted for free. Admission for crafters is \$6 per child or adult; \$5 for Friends of Wehr members. Additional projects—made by children or adults—are available for \$1 each.

To participate in the exchange, cookie-bakers are asked to make 4-10 dozen cookies and to donate one dozen cookies to the cookie sale. The rest of the cookies will be included in the exchange. Visitors can decorate a homemade sugar cookie for a small fee. Proceeds from the cookie sale will go to support Wehr’s accessibility renovations.
