## **Owl Prowl at Wehr Nature Center**

### ***Separate Programs for Adults, Families, and Scouts Search for Owls***

Franklin, WI (Jan. 16, 2014) – “Owl Prowl,” a night out with the owls, will be led by a Wehr Nature Center naturalist on five evenings in January, at 9701 W. College Ave.

Each interactive program highlights the habits and adaptations of owls, followed by a walk in the woodlands in search of Great Horned Owls and Eastern Screech Owls. A presentation on Wisconsin owls will follow the hike.

Owl Prowl for Adults will be offered Jan. 17 and 18, from 7-9 p.m.; Owl Prowl for Families, recommended for children age 6 and up, will be Jan. 24 and 25, from 6:30-8:30 p.m.; and the new Owl Prowl for Scouts, for youth groups in second grade or above, will be Jan. 31, from 6:30-8:30 p.m.

Participants are reminded to dress in warm layers and bring flashlights.

Group size is limited, so those interested in attending should register by the Wednesday before the program.

Admission is \$10 for Non-MilwaukeeCounty residents, \$7 for Milwaukee County residents, and \$5 for Friends of Wehr.
