8th Annual Irish Family Days at The Domes *Fun for the Entire Family*

Milwaukee, WI (Feb. 24, 2014) “Irish Family Day at The Domes” will bring a bit of the Emerald Isle’s culture, food, and music to Milwaukee, Sunday, March 9, from 9 a.m.–4 p.m. The Mitchell Park Domes, “Milwaukee’s Living Landmark,” is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

“St. Patrick’s Day is traditionally a day for family,” said Patrick Boyle, Executive Director of Milwaukee Irish Fest, “and ‘Irish Family Day at the Domes’ is a family-friendly venue to celebrate this culture.”

Music and dance performances will fill the day. Performers include the local Milwaukee Irish band, “Blarney”; the Celtic band, “Lollycoogan”; Irish folk musician, Rory Modlinski; Irish dancers from the Cashel Dennehy School of Irish Dance; Irish harpists, MaryAnn Miller and Isabel Sovitzky; a strolling musician, Lyle Holthaus; and the Irish Fest School of Music students.

Volunteers will demonstrate and display Irish lace-making and flax-spinning, and a storyteller will present the true story of St. Patrick. Activities for children include making an art project and learning to dance an Irish jig.

Food with an Irish flair will be available for purchase from Zilli’s Hospitality Group.

Unique Irish gift items will also be available for purchase.

“Irish Family Day at The Domes” is included with regular admission. Admission for adults age 18 and over is \$7; Milwaukee County Seniors with ID, persons with disabilities, students of any age with ID, and youth age 6-17 are \$5. Children 5 and under are admitted for free.
