“Dare to be Aware Fair” Returns to The Domes

Milwaukee (March 19, 2014) – “Dare to Be Aware Fair,” a gathering of 60 exhibitors focused on expanding well-being and personal growth, will offer free workshops, demonstrations, and performances at The Domes, Sun., April 6, from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. The Domes, “Milwaukee’s Living Landmark,” is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

Twelve free presentations and workshops will be offered, including “Awakening to Your Angels,” the keynote presentation by Nancy Frier. The keynote presentation will focus on how listening to the inner voice answers prayers.
