“Family Frog Frolic” at Wehr Nature Center

Franklin, WI (April 7, 2014) – Wehr Nature Center will present an interactive, family program about Wisconsin frogs and toads that includes a walk to hear the “chorusing” of frogs, Friday, April 25, from 7-9 p.m. The Nature Center is located in Whitnall Park at 9701 W. College Ave.

In early spring, some tiny frogs put on quite a concert. At less than 1-1/2” long, the Western Chorus Frog sings loudly enough to be heard about a half-mile away. Spring Peepers may join in with a sound like sleigh bells jingling, and the much larger Wood Frog may add a croaking baseline to the chorus.

Family Frog Frolic will begin with an introduction and one-on-one time with live amphibians. Next, participants will join a naturalist on a walk to the ponds and wetlands of Wehr. Here the frogs and toads will present themselves as harbingers of spring.

The program is designed for adults and families with children age 5 and up. Adults may bring flashlights. Because the program includes an outdoor component in wetlands and near the ponds, participants are reminded to dress for the weather and the mud.

Pre-registration is requested by Wednesday, April 23. The fee per person is \$10; Milwaukee County Residents, \$7; and Friends of Wehr Members, \$5. The regular \$3 parking fee is in effect.
