Whitnall Park Ropes Course Public Information Meeting

WHO:
Milwaukee County Parks, Adventure Forest LLC d/b/a Go Ape Whitnall Park, LLC

WHAT:
Public Information Meeting regarding the proposed ropes course in Whitnall Park. The proposed course would be located near the Ross Lodge, in the Village of Greendale.

WHERE:
Boerner Botanical Gardens, 9400 Boerner Drive, Hales Corners

WHEN:
Tuesday, April 15, 2014, at 5:30-7:30 p.m.

WHY:
The proposed course would provide an outdoor experience that provides 2-3 hours of outdoor fun and exercise. The course would allow participants to explore the park from an otherwise unobtainable vantage point while navigating through the treetops using zip lines, obstacles and tarzan swings.

Participants would be equipped with harnesses, pulleys, and carabiners, and would be given a 30-minute safety training. Instructors would always be on hand, regularly patrolling the forests.

Go Ape is the largest ropes course operator in the world, with six courses in the US (all located in public parks) and 28 courses in the United Kingdom
