### **“Reptile Day” Returns to Wehr Nature Center-** *A fun introduction to cold-blooded relatives*

Franklin, WI (May 20, 2014) —Meeting snakes, turtles, and lizards—up close and personal—is in store at Reptile Day, Sunday, June 8, from 1-4 p.m., at Wehr Nature Center, 9701 W. College Ave.

Families will see and learn about a variety of reptiles and amphibians from Wisconsin and around the world. Naturalists will hold many of the reptiles and give visitors the opportunity to touch or hold them as well. An assortment of children’s reptile-themed craft activities will complete the event. Refreshments will be available for purchase.

“Understanding how snakes, lizards, and amphibians help us can lead to a different approach the next time you see one in the wild,” said Ken Keffer, Wehr Naturalist and co-author of *The Kids' Outdoor Adventure Book: 448 Great Things to Do in Nature Before You Grow Up*.

Myths and reptile rumors, such as getting warts from a toad, will be put to rest, giving families the freedom to explore Wehr’s trails on their own in search of resident reptiles.

“The program gets kids involved—the first step to making a connection with the natural world,” Keffer said.

General admission is \$3 per person, \$2 per Friends of Wehr member. Parking is \$3 per car.
