Halloween Haunts: A Trek into The Enchanted Forest

Milwaukee, WI (Sept. 22, 2014) – Tickets to the annual Halloween Haunts—a humorous, educational and slightly spooky trek along a jack-o-lantern-lit trail—are now on sale to the general public at Wehr Nature Center, in Whitnall Park at 9701 W. College Ave.

Designed especially for families with children age 4-10, Halloween Haunts runs Thursday, Oct. 16 through Saturday, Oct. 18. Families purchase tickets for a specific time slot to follow the Night Travelers, or guides, into the Enchanted Forest.

“Purchase your tickets early or you don’t stand a ghost of a chance!” said Bev Bryant, Wehr Nature Center Naturalist and coordinator of Halloween Haunts. “The trip through the Enchanted Forest is just spooky enough to keep the kids enthralled—it is *not* designed to give anyone a nightmare! In fact, most folks leave with smiles on their faces and a new appreciation for nature’s misunderstood creatures.”

Along the tour, families will meet creepy characters, such as the wise-cracking Mr. Bones, Mutant Frog, and The Decomposers, who will talk about the connection between humans and nature’s misunderstood Halloween creatures.

Departure times for the 45-minute hike are scheduled every seven minutes, from 6:30-8:30 p.m. The event goes on, rain or shine.

Indoor activities include fortune telling, face painting, crafts, and games.

One adult must accompany every five children. The ticket purchase limit is 16 per person.

Ticket prices are \$10 for non-Milwaukee County Residents, and \$7 for Milwaukee County Residents and members of Friends of Wehr. Parking is free.

Volunteer opportunities for character actors, decorating, and pumpkin-carving are available. Character auditions will be by appointment only through Sept. 30.
