Music Under Glass Concert Schedule Announced

Light Shows, Live Music, Great Food and Drink—Every Thursday Night

Milwaukee (Dec. 16, 2014) – The Milwaukee County Parks has announced the concert schedule for Music Under Glass (MUG), the concert series at the Mitchell Park Domes. Live performances and computer-generated light shows will fill The Domes every Thursday night, Jan. 8–March 19, 2015 thanks to support from Blue Moon Brewing Company. The Domes, Milwaukee’s Living Landmark, is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

“Music Under Glass has been a winter getaway and cure for cabin fever since 2009,” said Milwaukee County Executive, Chris Abele. “Every week, visitors and residents alike enjoy our area’s talent. Over the last series—even with our bitter-cold winter—more than 11,000 people attended MUG!”

The 2015 series opens with Eric Diamond’s tribute to Neil Diamond and continues with a variety of musical genres. Concerts run from 6:30-9:30 p.m., with light shows at the breaks and following the performance.

During the run of the concert series, two of the most popular floral shows will be on display. The Hawaiian-themed holiday show currently on display, Mele Kalikimaka, brings a bit of Polynesia to the Show Dome through Jan. 4. Then the show dome will transition to the garden train show, “A Space Odyssey,” opening Jan. 17. This show will feature G-scale trains running on over 600 feet of track, surrounded by a landscape of miniature plants.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase from Zilli Hospitality Group.

Admission to “Music Under Glass” is \$7 for adults and \$5 for youths age 6-17. When proof of status is shown, the \$5 rate is also available to resident seniors, students, and persons with disabilities.
