Bonsai Society to Exhibit at The Domes

Milwaukee (Jan. 12, 2015) – The Milwaukee Bonsai Society’s “Winter Silhouettes,” an exhibit focusing on the form of intricately pruned dwarf trees, will be on view at The Domes, Sunday, Feb. 8, from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. Bonsai resemble very old trees as part of a natural landscape. The Domes, “Milwaukee’s Living Landmark,” is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

“Without the dressing of buds, leaves, and flowers, the trees reveal the way bonsai artists focus on structure,” said Greg Polak, President of the Milwaukee Bonsai Society.

Only deciduous trees will be on display. Species may include Maple, hornbeam, elm, hawthorn, apple, crabapple, pomegranate, crape myrtle, ginkgo, larch, and swamp cypress.

Members of the Milwaukee Bonsai Society will be on hand to answer visitors’ questions.

While at the exhibit, visitors are welcome to view the most popular show of the year—the garden train show. The theme of this year’s show is “A Space Odyssey,” a futuristic train show featuring space houses and flying saucers in an alien landscape in a galaxy far, far away.

“Winter Silhouettes” and “A Space Odyssey” are included with regular admission. Admission for adults age 18 and over is \$7; Milwaukee County Seniors with ID, persons with disabilities, students of any age with ID, and youth age 6-17 are \$5. Children 5 and under are admitted for free.
