Milwaukee Area Trails Gathering at The Domes

Milwaukee, WI (May 26, 2015) – The Milwaukee Area Trails Gathering at The Domes will give area residents the opportunity to learn about current trail projects and activities, in an open-house format, Wednesday, June 10, from 5–7 p.m.. The Domes, “Milwaukee’s Living Landmark,” is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

Presented through the partnership of the Milwaukee County Trails Council and Milwaukee Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force, this free event will give trail enthusiasts the opportunity to talk with municipal trail professionals and members of local trails groups and to see plans for facilities for pedestrians, bicyclists, and other trail users.

Among the plans on display will be the Menomonee River Parkway renewal project and the extension of the Oak Leaf Trail north of the Estabrook Parkway.

The new Parks trails map will be available for purchase at the event. Trails included on the map are the Oak Leaf Recreational Trail, corridors of the Oak Leaf Discovery Tour, Hank Aaron Trail, and municipal off-road trails. Also indicated on the map are locations of the Forked Aster Hiking Trails, Milwaukee Urban Water Trail, Lake Michigan State Water Trail, mountain bike trails, and eBird birding hotspots.

While at the event, visitors are welcome to explore The Domes. “Practically Perfect in Every Way,” the summer floral show, will offer a whimsical look at early-1900s London, complete with sidewalk chalk art and chimney sweeps on the rooftops.
