Nature Photographs on View at Boerner Botanical Gardens

Hales Corners, WI (June 18, 2015) — Nature photographs by Jim Poliak will be on display June 27–July 19 in the Garden House of the Boerner Botanical Gardens in Whitnall Park. The Botanical Gardens, “Milwaukee County’s Living Museum,” is located at 9400 Boerner Drive.

Poliak’s photography is inspired by the diversity of nature. His love of the great outdoors provides him the opportunity to capture unusual qualities of light and uncommon portraits of wildlife. Poliak has photographed the erratic and unpredictable to the serene—from a hawk clutching a mouse in its talons, to a mother hummingbird feeding her baby in the nest.

Visitors will have the opportunity to meet the artist during special hours, Thursday, July 9, from 3–8 p.m.

Garden House regular hours are 8 a.m.–6 p.m., seven days a week. The Botanical Gardens are open daily until dusk.

Admission to the Botanical Gardens, which includes admission to the Garden House, is \$5.50 for adults age 18 and up; \$4.50 for students of any age with IDs, Milwaukee County seniors age 60 and up with IDs, and people with disabilities; and \$3.50 for youths age 6-17. Free admission is offered to Milwaukee County residents with ID and proof of residency on “First Tuesdays,” the first Tuesday of the month. Admission to the gardens requires wearing the official daily wristband.
