Professional Golfers to Compete at Brown Deer Park Golf Course *with On-Course “Beer Crawl” for Spectators*

Milwaukee, WI (July 23, 2015) – Up-and-coming professional female golfers from around the world will be at Brown Deer Golf Course July 31-Aug. 2 to compete in the PHC Classic, an event on the Symetra Tour, the Road to the LPGA. The event, free to spectators, will take place at 7625 N. Range Line Road.

“We are thrilled to bring professional golf back to Milwaukee County through our partnership with Symetra, the Forest County Potawatomi Nation, and Potawatomi Hotel & Casino,” said Milwaukee County Executive Chris Abele. “Milwaukee County Parks continue to offer a premier destination for golf, and we are excited to show Brown Deer Golf Course off in hosting this great event.”

The field of 144 golfers will compete for a prize purse of \$100,000. Professionals include four Wisconsin natives (Gabby Curtis of Eau Claire, Jessie Gerry of Madison, Carly Werwie of Kenosha, and Allyssa Ferrell of Edgerton) along with golfers from 22 different countries from Australia to Venezuela. Also included are players who have won this season on the Symetra Tour (Daniela Iacobelli, Augusta James, Jimin Kang, Katie Kempster, Sue Kim, Alejandra Llana, Haruka Morita-WanyaoLu, Annie Park, Rachel Rohanna, and Madeleine Sheils).

Putting a twist on the experience for spectators at this tournament is the Beer Crawl. In addition to seeing some of the best players in the world, spectators may purchase a Beer Crawl card for \$20. With the card, visitors can stop at four different Sprecher stations along the course to enjoy a beverage while watching the tournament. After visiting all four stops and having their Beer Crawl cards punched, patrons will turn in their cards for the chance to win prizes.

For additional food and beverage options, the Traveling Beer Garden will be set up near the clubhouse and will be serving Sprecher’s beers, sodas, authentic German food, and snacks.
