## **Final Weekend at Deep-Well Pools** *Family Aquatic Parks Remain Open through Labor Day*

Milwaukee, WI (Aug. 21, 2015) – Milwaukee County’s deep-well pools will offer the final weekend of swimming Aug. 22 and 23, with Saturday being a nearly perfect day for swimming. A predicted high of 83 degrees and sunny skies will kick off the weekend.

Pools at Hales Corners, Holler, Jackson, Kosciuszko (Pelican Cove), McCarty, Oak Creek Parkway (Grobschmidt Pool), Sheridan, Washington, and Wilson will be open through Sunday at 4:30 p.m. The pool at Wilson will re-open Aug. 24-Sept. 4 for lap swim (7-10 a.m.) and water exercise (9-10 a.m.).

Wading pools remaining open through Sunday are Alcott, Algonquin, Greene, Holler, Humboldt, Kops, LaFollette, Lindsay, Lyons, McCarty, Mitchell, Pulaski-Cudahy, Saveland, Sheridan, Sherman, Tippecanoe, Wahl, Washington, and Wedgewood. Splash pads closed earlier this season.

Milwaukee County’s two family aquatic parks, Cool Waters in Greenfield Park and the David F. Schulz Aquatic Center in Lincoln Park, will remain open through Labor Day.

After Cool Waters has closed for the "human swimming season," and before it is drained for the year, it will open for a Doggie Dip at 6:30 p.m. on Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 7. Whether fearless about diving for tennis balls or wearing a personal floatation device, dogs of all abilities, breeds, and sizes are welcome to come for a swim in the pool.
