Hand-Crafted Jewelry by Local Bead Artists at The Domes

Milwaukee, WI (Oct. 16, 2015) – Hand-crafted jewelry by local bead artists will be for sale at Jewelry at The Domes, an annual show presented by the Loose Bead Society of Greater Milwaukee, Nov. 14 from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. The Domes, Milwaukee’s Living Landmark, is located at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

About 30 artists will sell their unique beaded and hand-crafted jewelry, accessories, and decorative items—just in time for holiday gift-giving.

A variety of techniques were used in creating the original pieces. Bead weaving, bead embroidery, and beaded braiding, along with wirework and metalwork are among the methods used in traditional and innovative ways.

Materials used range from polymer, precious-metal and epoxy clays to resin and glass.

The Loose Bead Society of Greater Milwaukee was formed in 1999 as a fellowship of kindred spirits with the purpose of sharing and promoting the creation of beautiful beadwork.

Entrance to Jewelry at The Domes is included with regular Domes admission. Admission for adults age 18 and over is \$7; Milwaukee County Seniors with ID, persons with disabilities, students of any age with ID, and youth age 6-17 are \$5. Children 5 and under are admitted for free.
