re:Craft and Relic Show to Open at Sports Complex Nov. 14-15

Milwaukee, WI (Oct. 26, 2015) – Over 250 makers of up-cycled, reclaimed, and handcrafted items will sell their wares at the new re:Craft and Relic Show, Nov. 14-15 at the 55,000-square-foot Milwaukee County Sports Complex. Regular show hours are 10 a.m.-4p.m. The Sports Complex is located at 6000 W. Ryan Road.

With lovers of Pinterest, Etsy, and the DIY movement showing strong interest in all things vintage, salvaged, industrial, handmade, and re-purposed, the event producer Open Productions is offering a Buyer's Club component that allows 200 people to purchase tickets online for early admission on Saturday from 9-10 a.m.

Makers and vendors from across the Midwest are only one aspect of the show. A consignment boutique with furniture, artwork, and home accessories, stage demonstrations and DIY workshops, hourly giveaways, and raffles comprise the show. Musical entertainment and food and beverages from local restaurants and food trucks round out the event.

For holiday shoppers, this is the show to attend. The next re:Craft and Relic Show is April 23-24, 2016.

Regular admission is \$7 at the door; advance online purchase, \$5; and advance online Buyer's Club ticket \$20. The Buyer's Club package includes admission both days with early admission on Saturday, a one-of-a-kind burlap tote bag, a free-beverage ticket, discounts from vendors, and other perks totaling a \$100 value.

Parking is free.
