Final Lifeguard Training Begins Sunday

Milwaukee, WI (May 20, 2016) – Wisconsin swimmers, age 16 and older, interested in lifeguarding for the Milwaukee County Parks this summer have one last opportunity to take the required in-water training course, beginning Sunday, May 22, from 8 a.m.–1 p.m., at Pulaski Pool, 2701 S. 16 St.

The four-part course also meets from 7–9 p.m., Tuesday-Thursday, May 24–26. Attendance at all classes is required.

At the first class, would-be-lifeguards must demonstrate their ability to swim 100 meters in under 1 minute and 45 seconds. Candidates must also pass an in-water skills test, Saturday, May 28, starting at 7 a.m. First aid training must also be completed for a candidate to be eligible for employment as a lifeguard.

Candidates offered positions as lifeguards will be placed at 15 locations throughout the County.

Starting pay is about \$10.25 per hour.
