Cooking with Herbs Demonstration at Wehr Nature Center July 12

Franklin, WI (July 7, 2016) – Cooking with fresh herbs will be demonstrated—and sampled—at a fundraising event for Wehr Nature Center, July 12, from 6:30-9 p.m. The Nature Center is located at 9701 W. College Ave.

Staci Joers of Cooking with Class will demonstrate preparation of a three-course meal, with each course featuring a different herb. She will prepare Warm Goat Cheese on Garlic Pitas with Sun-dried Tomatoes and Freshly Made Pesto, Rosemary Roast Pork Loin with Thyme Gravy, Roasted Garlic Mashed Potatoes with Chives, and individual Almond Tortes with Fresh Berries & Spiced Cream.

“My classes are designed to show the novice how to prepare wonderful dishes with a gourmet flare. And although I’ve designed my classes to appeal to new cooks, seasoned veterans also enjoy them and come away with new ideas and a few things they didn’t know,” Joers said.

Sampling all foods, a glass of wine or other beverage, and all recipes are included in admission. General admission is \$30 per person, or \$25 per member of Friends of Wehr.
