Homemade Holidays Open House at Wehr Nature Center, Dec. 3

MILWAUKEE (Nov. 8, 2016) – Homemade Holidays, Wehr Nature Center’s annual open house, will give families the opportunity to make gifts from natural, recycled, and repurposed objects, Saturday, Dec. 3, from 11 a.m. –3 p.m. Wehr is located at 9701 W. College Ave. in Whitnall Park.

To slow the hectic pace of the holidays, to avoid the crowded malls, and to make unique gifts for the special people in their lives, families can stop in any time during the event hours.

Making three different projects is included in the admission fee for crafters. Projects include pencil holders, stone sculptures, jewelry, a variety of holiday ornaments, homemade cards, and pinecone holiday trees. The program is recommended for children age 5 and up.

Non-crafters will be admitted for free. Admission for crafters is \$6 per child or adult; \$5 for Friends of Wehr members. Additional projects—made by children or adults—will be available for \$1 each.

Visitors may also decorate homemade sugar cookies for \$1. Proceeds from the cookie sale will go to support Wehr’s accessibility renovations.

Families and individuals may pay at the door. Scout and other youth groups must register by Nov. 30.
