Guided Walk to Focus on Plants That Changed Human History, Nov. 12

MILWAUKEE (Nov. 8, 2016) – The Mitchell Park Domes is offering area residents and visitors the opportunity to go on a guided tour of the world of plants, Nov. 12 from 10 a.m.–noon at the three domes at 524 S. Layton Blvd.

Along the indoor guided tour, participants will see and sample some of the plants that humans depend on for air, food, medicine, and more.

Twelve Plants that Changed Human History will explore the impact on civilization of barley, black pepper, cane sugar, Cinchona (quinine), cocoa, coffee, cotton, date palm, rubber, potato, rice, and wheat.

Admission is \$12 per adult (age 18 and up), or \$10 for members of Friends of the Domes, Milwaukee County Seniors (age 60+ with proof of residency), Students (with school ID), and Children (under age 18).
