




# Forked Aster Hiking Trail System

### Falk Park

This park is an ecologically diverse southern mesic forest containing numerous ephemeral wetlands and a small meandering stream. Naturalists have documented 156 unique plant species and 57 bird species within the park. Visitors can see these treasures along the hiking trails in spring, summer, and fall.
