




Forked Aster Hiking Trail System




Mangan Woods

Located on the southern Root River Parkway, Mangan Woods contains some of the largest old-growth hardwoods in the Park System. The stand is found in the southwest corner of the site. Mature northern red oaks and sugar maples provide a dense canopy over prevalent ground flora, including a number of rare plant species. This park also provides birding opportunities.
