




# Forked Aster Hiking Trail System

**Collecting is strictly prohibited.**





### Rawson Park

This natural area is one of the best remaining examples of beech-maple forest in the Park System. The greatest diversity of trees, plants, and wildlife are found in the northern half of this woodland. Due to its close proximity to Lake Michigan and the Oak Creek Parkway, this unique park acts as an important stopover site for spring and fall migratory birds.
